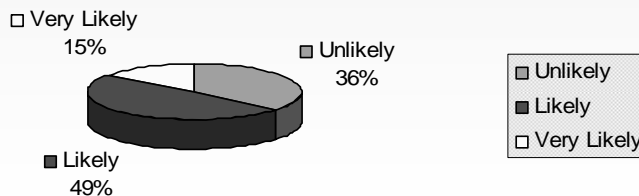


The Use of Screening to Identify and Engage Students at Risk: Campus Example

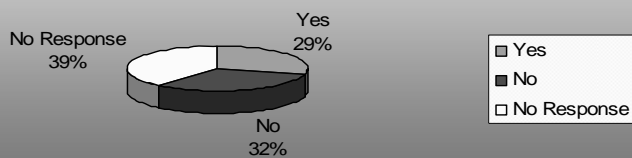
Severity of Depression (%)

Of the 182 students who self administered the online assessment tool 36.26% were unlikely to be depressed, 48.90% were likely to be depressed and 14.84% were very likely to be depressed.

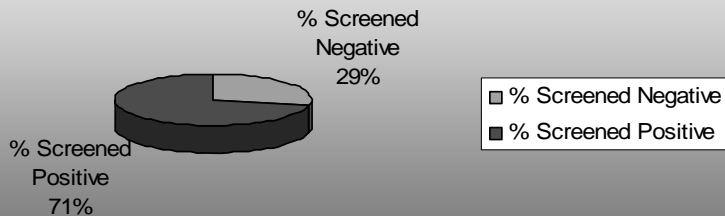
Regarding depression...

Of the 62 students who screened positive for depression who responded to the question, "Do You Plan to Seek Further Evaluation for Depression?"



Of the 97 WPI students who self administered the online screening survey, 28.87% reported GAD symptoms were not present. 71.13% screened positive which indicates that GAD symptoms were present at the time of screening.

More on Generalized Anxiety Disorder

- 97 students answered the treatment profile section on the GAD screening.
- Of those who scored positive, 95.65% were not in treatment.
- 37% indicated they would seek further evaluation
- 39% indicated they would not seek further evaluation
- 24% did not indicate if they would seek further evaluation
