TWO-SPIRIT

Two-spirit is a term preferred by Native American peoples that unifies LGBTQI human beings. The Two-Spirit gender role is not based in sexual activities or practices, but rather is a sacred position within tribes as foster parents, philosophers, nurses and/or therapists and chiefs. The existence of cross-gender roles, the male-female, the female-male, are what we now call the Two-Spirited people.
